Professor S. S. Kutateladze
1914–1986



ON 20 March 1986 death has taken away Professor Samson Semyonovich Kutateladze, prominent Soviet scientist in the fields of power engineering, thermal physics and physical hydro-aerodynamics, member of the Presidium of the Siberian Branch of the U.S.S.R. Academy of Sciences, Director of the Institute of Thermophysics of the Siberian Branch of the U.S.S.R. Academy of Sciences, Full Member of the U.S.S.R. Academy of Sciences, Hero of Socialist Labour, State Prize Winner, member of the Honorary Advisory Board of the International Journal of Heat and Mass Transfer, one of the organizers and oldest members of the Assembly of International Heat Transfer Conferences, member of the Scientific Council of the International Centre for Heat and Mass Transfer (an article on his activities was published on the occasion of his 70th birthday in this journal in Vol. 27, No. 11, pp. 1945–1946, 1984).

The scientific achievements of Professor S. S. Kutateladze have widely been acknowledged in our country and abroad. His untimely death causes deep regret among the scientific community.
